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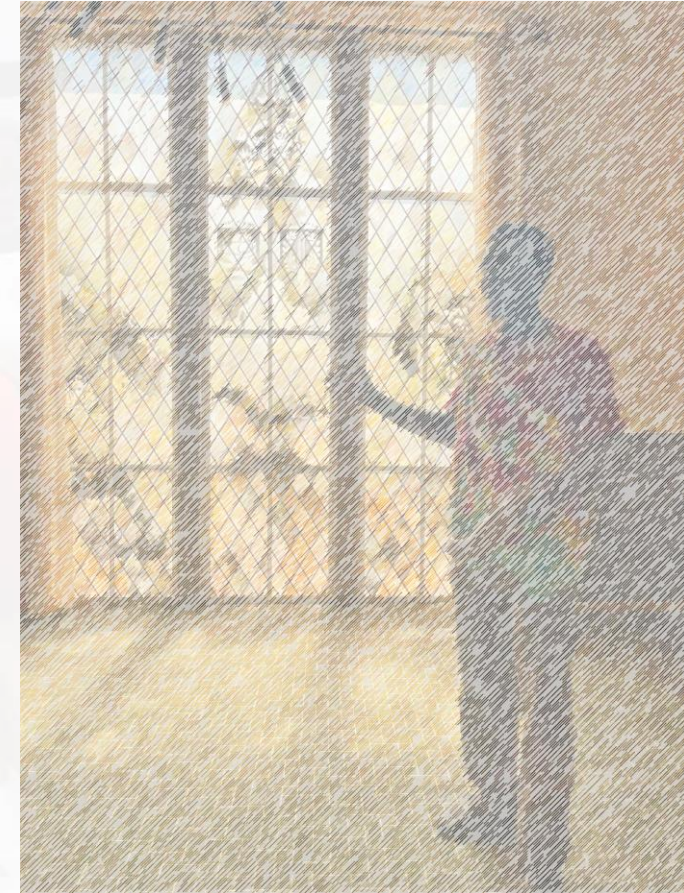

To examine the ways emotions come to matter in tourism encounters at contested heritage sites, for whom and for which moral attitudes toward reconciling with the past.

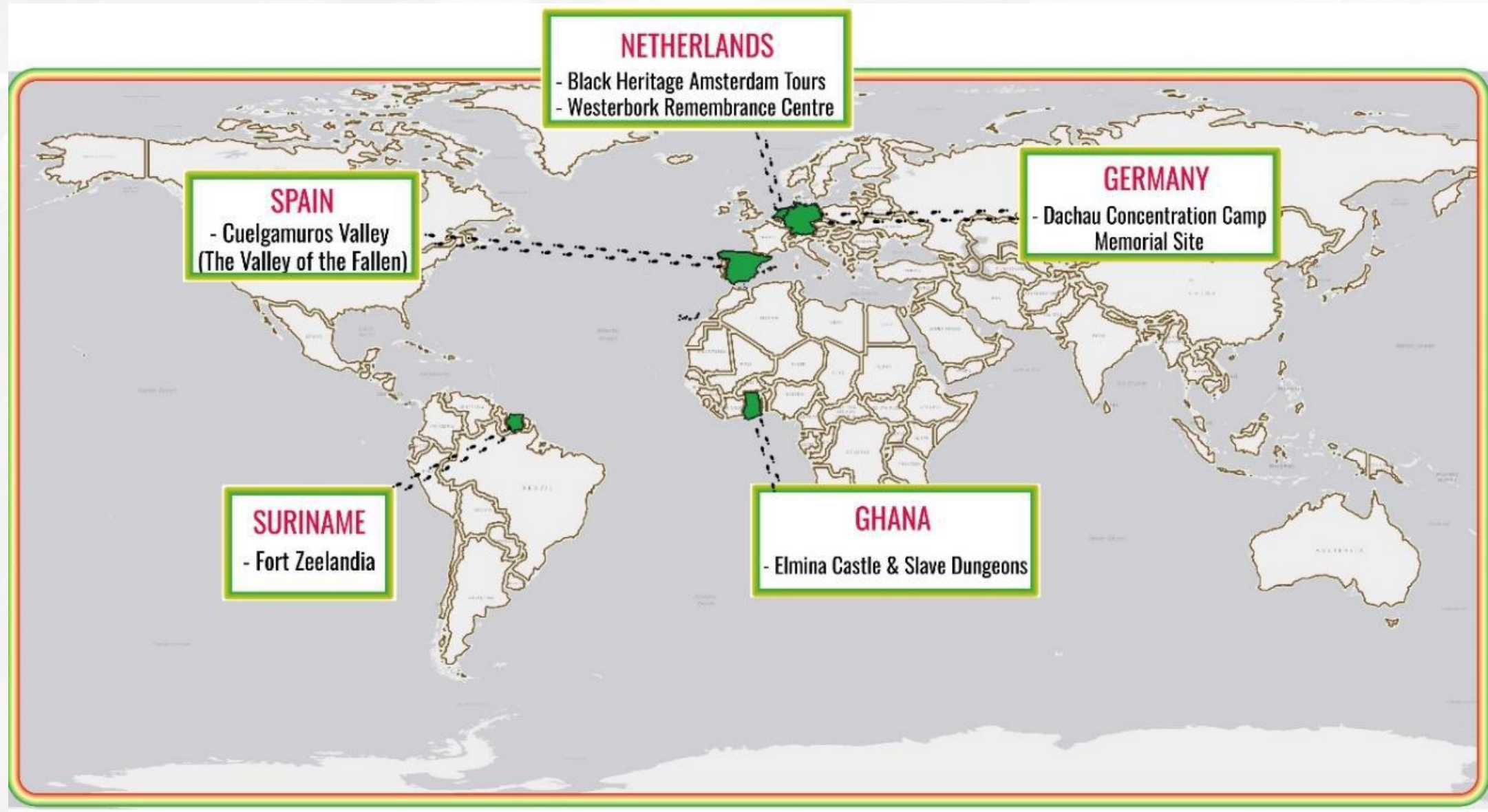

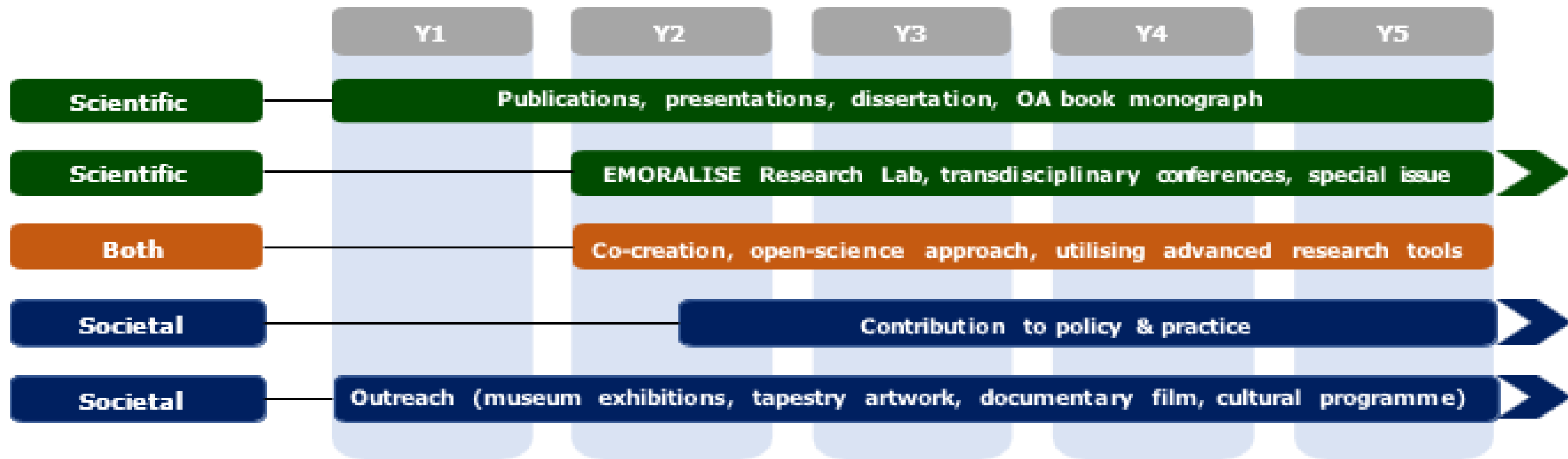
